

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Mohawk Fabric Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on July 18, 2013. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Montgomery County Clerk at County Office Building, PO Box 1500, Fonda, NY 12068 and City of Amsterdam City Clerk at 61 Church Street, Amsterdam, NY 12010. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the acquisition and renovation of 14,000-square-foot vacant parcel of land, and the acquisition of machinery & equipment for a new manufacturing facility at 96-108 Guy Park Avenue, Amsterdam by Mohawk Fabric Company. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$806,000. ESD proposes to make a \$48,000 grant to Mohawk Fabric Company to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project is expected to 7 retain jobs and create 3 jobs within January 1, 2014 years after disbursement of the ESD funds.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Amsterdam City Hall, Common Council Chambers, 61 Church Street, Amsterdam, NY 12010 on Wednesday, August 14, 2013 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM, to consider the Plan.
