

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Griffiss Local Development Corporation Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on July 18, 2013. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Oneida County Clerk at the Oneida County Office Building, 800 Park Avenue, Utica, NY 13501 and the City of Rome Clerk’s Office at City Hall, 198 N. Washington Street, Rome, NY 13440. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the acquisition of machinery & equipment for a facility that will house a high speed network at 725 Daedalian Drive, Rome by Griffiss Local Development Corporation. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$838,800 ESD proposes to make a \$397,500 grant to Griffiss Local Development Corporation to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project is expected to provide a technology infrastructure that will stimulate new jobs in IT and cyber-security jobs.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the City of Rome, Common Council Chambers, 198 N. Washington Street, Rome, NY 13440, on Thursday, August 15, 2013 from 9:30 AM to 10:30 AM, to consider the Plan. (Please note that eating, drinking and smoking are not allowed in the chambers).
