

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Rensselaer County - Hurricane Irene - Tropical Storm Lee Flood Mitigation Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on September 19, 2013. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes flood mitigation activities to reduce future flooding at the Project Locations at the Towns of Brunswick, East Nassau, Hoosick, Nassau, Petersburg, Poestenkill, Schaghticoke, Stephentown in Rensselaer County by Rensselaer County. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$681,415 and ESD proposes to make a \$341,260 grant to Rensselaer County to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project is expected to reduce future flooding at the Project Locations.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Troy City Hall, City Council Chambers, 433 River street, 5th Floor, Troy, NY 12180 on Wednesday, October 9, 2013 from 1:00 PM to 2:00 PM , to consider the Plan.
