

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Time Warner Cable Broadband Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on February 20, 2014. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Ulster County Clerk, 244 Fair Street, Kingston, NY 12401; the Schoharie County Clerk, 284 Main Street, Schoharie, NY 12157; the Otsego County Clerk, 197 Main Street, Cooperstown, NY 13326 ; Oneida County Clerk, Oneida County Office Building, 800 Park Avenue, Utica, NY 13501; Herkimer County Clerk, 109 Mary Street, Suite 1111, Herkimer, NY 13350 and the Rensselaer County Clerk, 105 Third Street, Troy, NY 12180. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The \$7,010,975 project will deploy a state-of-the-art fiber and coaxial network to bring high-speed broadband to unserved areas. This project, which is expected to be complete in December 2014, will expand broadband services to 4,104 households, 8 businesses and 2 Community Anchor institutions. ESD proposes to make a grant of up to \$5,258,231 to assist in the financing of this project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation in March 12, 2014 from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at the Schoharie County Office Bldg., 284 Main Street, 3rd Floor, Room 360, Schoharie, NY 12157 to consider the Plan.
