

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Tompkins County - Hurricane Irene - Tropical Storm Lee Flood Mitigation Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors’ meeting on March 28, 2014. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Tompkins County Clerk at the Main Courthouse, 320 North Tioga Street, Ithaca, NY 14850 and Caroline Town Clerk, 2670 Slaterville Road, Slaterville Springs, NY 14881. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes flood mitigation activities to reduce future flooding in a project location in the Town of Caroline by Tompkins County. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$52,470 and ESD proposes to make a \$13,117 grant to Tompkins County to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project is expected to create an adjustment to the stream channel path and ensure the Six Hundred Road will not be flooded in a future flood event.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Town of Caroline, Historic Town Hall Court Room, 2670 Slaterville Road, Slaterville Springs, NY 14881 on Tuesday, April 15, 2014 from 3:00 p.m to 4:00 p.m to consider the Plan.
