

## LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Montgomery County - Hurricane Irene - Tropical Storm Lee Flood Mitigation Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on March 28, 2014. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Montgomery County Clerk, Montgomery County Office Building, 64 Broadway, Fonda, NY 12068; the Town of Glen Clerk, 7 Erie Street, Fultonville, NY 12072; Town of Florida Clerk, 214 Fort Hunter Road, Amsterdam, NY 12010; and the Town of Amsterdam Clerk, 283 Manny's Corner Road, Amsterdam, NY 12010. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project involves flood mitigation activities to reduce future flooding at the four Project Locations. The projects include debris removal and the installation of rip rap to stabilize stream paths in the Towns of Amsterdam, Florida and Glen by Montgomery County. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$518,375 ESD proposes to make a \$418,249 grant to Montgomery County to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project is expected to remediate, mitigate and reduce future flooding in the Project Locations.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Town of Amsterdam Town Hall, Town Meeting Room, 283 Manny's Corner Road, Amsterdam, NY 12010 on Tuesday, April 15, 2014 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM, to consider the Plan.
