

## LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the New York Genome Center Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on July 17, 2014. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the New York County Clerk at 60 Centre Street, Rm 161, New York, NY 10007 and the New York City Clerk of the Council, Executive Office, 141 Worth Street, New York, NY 10013. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes construction and renovation and the acquisition and installation of specialized machinery and equipment at the 168,000-square-foot genomic research facilities at 101 Avenue of the Americas, New York by New York Genome Center. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$158,500,000, ESD proposes to make a \$57,250,000 grant to New York Genome Center to assist in the financing of the Project. The NYGC has committed to retain 33 existing jobs and create 500 new jobs within January 1, 2017 after disbursement of the ESD funds..

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Adelphi University, 75 Varick Street, Rooms 260/261, New York, NY 10013 on Monday, August 11, 2014 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM, to consider the Plan.
