

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Ulster County - Hurricane Irene - Tropical Storm Lee Flood Mitigation Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on October 16, 2014. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Ulster County Clerk, City of Kingston, 244 Fair Street, Kingston, NY 12401 and the Ulster County Executive, 170 Hamilton Avenue, Suite 301, White Plains, NY 10601. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the General Public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes flood mitigation projects, such as stream stabilization and debris removal in Ulster County by Ulster County. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$1,552,742. ESD proposes to make a \$389,863 grant to Ulster County to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Ulster County Legislative Chambers, 244 Fair Street, Kingston, NY 12402 on Friday, November 14, 2014 from 10:00 am to 11:00 am to consider the Plan.
