

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Tech Valley High School STEM Connect Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors’ meeting on February 19, 2015. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Albany County Clerk at Albany County Courthouse, 16 Eagle Street, Room 128, Albany, NY 12207. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes costs to construct and fit-up the Zero Energy (“ZEN”) Extension building to accommodate the Tech Valley High School Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (“STEM”) Connect project, a collaboration between Tech Valley High School, SUNY Polytechnic Institute (“SPI”), the newly merged SUNY College of Nanoscale Science and Engineering (“CNSE”) and SUNY Institute of Technology, and Fuller Road Management Corporation (“FRMC”) at 246 Tricentennial Drive, Albany, NY. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$9,000,000. ESD proposes to make a \$1,500,000 grant to Fuller Road Management Corporation to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Albany City Hall, 24 Eagle Street, Mayor’s Conference Room, Albany, NY 12207 on March 10, 2015 at 10:00 a.m., to consider the Plan.
