

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Schenectady Museum Association Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on June 25, 2015. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Schenectady County Clerk at 105 Jay Street, Schenectady, NY 12305. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the purchase and installation of a high-definition dome projection system, seating, installation and floor repair of carpet tiles at 15 Nott Terrace Heights, Schenectady, NY, by the Schenectady Museum Association (miSci). Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$68,227. ESD proposes to make a \$20,137 grant to Schenectady Museum Association to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Schenectady City Hall, 105 Jay Street, Room 110, Schenectady, NY 12305 on July 14, 2015 at 10:00 a.m., to consider the Plan.
