

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”) , has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Peconic Land Trust Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on August 20, 2015. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in offices of the Suffolk County Clerk at 310 Center Drive, Riverhead, NY 11901 and the Southampton Town Clerk, 116 Hampton Road, Southampton, NY 11968. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the acquisition of machinery & equipment to be purchased through a grant program established by Peconic Land Trust, Inc. for 50-100 emerging and established farmers to start or grow their businesses, and to meet more stringent food quality and safety standards at various locations in Suffolk and Nassau counties. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$5,000,000. ESD proposes to make a \$1,000,000 grant to Peconic Land Trust, Inc. to assist in the financing of the Project. There are no jobs associated with this project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the W.H. Rogers Legislative Building, Clerks Conference Room, 725 Vets Memorial Highway, Hauppauge, NY 11787 on Monday, September 14, 2015 from 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm to consider the Plan.
