

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Willis Carrier Recreation Center Capital and Working Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on October 15, 2015. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Onondaga County Clerk at 401 Montgomery Street, Room 200, Syracuse, New York 13202 and in the office of the Dewitt Town Clerk at 5400 Butternut Drive, East Syracuse, New York 13057. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the construction of a one-of-kind, all-inclusive, outdoor multi-sports complex (the “Challenger Field of Dreams”) at 600 Roby Avenue, East Syracuse, New York by the Town of Dewitt and creation of a marketing campaign to promote its use and enjoyment by all residents and visitors of Central New York. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$10,247,500. ESD proposes to make a \$100,500 capital grant and a \$147,000 working capital grant to Town of Dewitt to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Dewitt Town Offices located at 5400 Butternut Drive, Meeting Room B, East Syracuse, New York, on Friday, November 6, 2015, at 3:00pm to consider the Plan.
