

## LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the MVEDGE - Marcy Nanocenter Interceptor Phase 1B Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on May 18, 2015. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Oneida County Clerk at Oneida County Office Building, 800 Park Avenue, Utica, NY 13501 and the Town of Marcy Clerk, Town of Marcy Town Building, 8801 Paul Becker Road, Marcy, NY 13403. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project involves site development of the Marcy Nanocenter including wetland and stream mitigation, storm water systems, clearing and grubbing, fencing, cutting and filling to build the terrace structure for future buildings, design and permitting for the 345kv transmission line and other design work by Economic Development Growth Enterprises. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$7,054,485. ESD proposes to make two grants totaling \$4,250,000 to Economic Development Growth Enterprises to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Town of Marcy Town Building, 8801 Paul Becker Road, Marcy, NY 13403 on Monday, June 8, 2015 from 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM, to consider the Plan.
