PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the The Solar Energy Consortium Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on May 18, 2015. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the acquisition of highly specialized machinery & equipment for a machinist training center located in Newburgh and testing/characterization/training labs located in four other facilities throughout the Mid-Hudson region, by The Solar Energy Consortium. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$3,480,000. ESD proposes to make a \$1,000,000 grant to The Solar Energy Consortium to assist in the financing of the Project.
