

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted General Project Plans (the “Plans”) with respect to the Onondaga Historical Association – Iroquois Heritage Center Capital Project (the “Project”) on February 18, 2016. Copies of the Plans are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plans in the office of the Onondaga County Clerk at 401 Montgomery Street, Room 200, Syracuse, New York 13202 and in the office of the Salina Town Clerk at 201 School Road, Liverpool, New York 13088. A copy of the Plans are also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the renovation and expansion of a facility for the Skanonh-Great Law of Peace Center that will promote heritage tourism, primarily focused on Haudenosaunee (Iroquois) people at 6680 Onondaga Lake Parkway, Liverpool, New York by the Onondaga Historical Association. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$400,000. ESD proposes to make two grants totaling up to \$160,000 to Onondaga Historical Association to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Salina Town Hall at 201 School Road, Liverpool, New York on March 7, 2016, at 3:00pm to consider the Plan.
