

## LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Central New York Hub for Emerging Nano Industries – Soraa Capital Project (the “Project”) at the Directors' meeting on February 18, 2016. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Onondaga County Clerk at 401 Montgomery Street, Room 200, Syracuse, New York 13202 and in the office of the Dewitt Town Clerk at 5400 Butternut Drive, East Syracuse, New York 13057. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the acquisition of real property, facility and infrastructure build-out, purchase and installation of specialized manufacturing equipment at SUNY Polytechnic Institute’s (“SUNY Poly”) Central New York Hub for Emerging Nano Industries at 50 Collamer Crossings Parkway, Dewitt, New York by Fort Schuyler Management Corporation. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$1,952,550,000. ESD proposes to make two grants totaling up to \$90,000,000 to Fort Schuyler Management Corporation to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project is expected to create 420 jobs.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Dewitt Town Offices located at 5400 Butternut Drive, East Syracuse, New York on March 11, 2016, at 1:00pm to consider the Plan.
