

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Craft Food & Beverage Center Capital Project (the “Project”) on June 23, 2016. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Otsego County Clerk and the Oneonta City Clerk. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the renovation and acquisition of machinery & equipment for the Craft Food and Beverage Center at 1 Hartwick Drive, Oneonta by Hartwick College. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$466,300. ESD proposes to make a \$60,000 grant to Hartwick College to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project is expected to create 3 jobs within 1 year after disbursement of the ESD funds.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the City of Oneonta, City Hall- Common Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, 258 Main Street, Oneonta, NY 13820 on July 13, 2016 from 10:30 AM to 11:30 AM, to consider the Plan.
