

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Historic Hudson River Towns Capital Project (the “Project”) on June 23, 2016. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Westchester County Clerk and the Ossining Village Clerk. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes a feasibility study and soft costs associated with site work to be done to prepare for a museum at Sing Sing at 354 Hunter Street, Ossining by Historic Hudson River Towns. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$1,385,000. ESD proposes to make a \$250,000 grant to Historic Hudson River Towns to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Village of Ossining-Village Hall, Board Room, 16 Croton Avenue, Ossining, NY 10562 on Friday, July 15, 2016 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM, to consider the Plan.
