

## LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Adirondack Barrel Cooperage Capital Project (the “Project”) at the Directors' meeting on February 18, 2016. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Town of Remsen Clerk and Oneida County Clerk. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the purchase of machinery and equipment, for manufacture and repair/reconditioning of high quality white oak barrels for craft distilleries, breweries, and wineries in the Northeastern United States at 1005 Williams Road Remsen, Remsen by Adirondack Barrel Cooperage. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$800,400 ESD proposes to make a \$60,000 grant to Adirondack Barrel Cooperage to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project is expected to create 4 jobs upon final disbursement of the ESD funds.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Town of Remsen - Town Hall, 10540 Academy Lane, Remsen, NY 13438 on Thursday March 10, 2016 from 2:00 PM to 3:00 PM, to consider the Plan.
