

## LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Hurricane Irene – Tropical Storm Lee Business Flood Recovery Grant Program Project (the “Project”) pursuant to the Directors' meeting on January 20, 2012. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Rensselaer County Clerk, County Office Building, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, 105 Third Street, Troy, NY 12180; Greene County Clerk, County Office Building, 411 Main Street, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Catskill, NY 12414; Albany County Clerk, County Court House, Room 128, 16 Eagle Street, Albany, NY 12207; Town of Coeymans Clerk, Town Hall, 18 Russell Avenue, Ravena, NY 12143; City of Cohoes Clerk, 97 Mohawk Street, Cohoes, NY 12047; Town of East Greenbush Clerk, Town Hall, 225 Columbia Turnpike, Rensselaer, NY 12144; and the Town of Windham Clerk, Town Hall, 371 State Route 296, Hensonville, New York 12439.

A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. In addition, a copy of the Plan is posted at [www.esd.ny.gov/PublicMeetings\\_Notices.html](http://www.esd.ny.gov/PublicMeetings_Notices.html).

The Project includes up to \$21 million of a \$50 million Hurricane Irene – Tropical Storm Lee Flood Recovery Grant appropriation to be used to provide local assistance grants to be used for storm-related repairs and restoration of structures, and for other storm related costs, with individual grants not to exceed 50% of storm-related damages, up to a maximum of \$20,000. Individual applicants located in the Capital region who are eligible for assistance are listed in the Plan.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Greene County Office of Economic Development, Tourism and Planning, County Office Building, 411 Main Street, Room 427, Catskill, NY 12414, on Thursday, April 11, 2013 from 10:00AM to 11:00AM to consider the Plan. In addition, ESD will accept written statements and comments about the Project submitted by 11:00 AM, April 11, 2013 sent to [hurricaneirene@esd.ny.gov](mailto:hurricaneirene@esd.ny.gov).
