## **ANNUAL REPORT: FISCAL YEAR APRIL 1, 2010 – MARCH 31, 2011**

As required by statute, this report contains the status of economic development programs administered by the Urban Development Corporation, doing business as the Empire State Development Corporation (“ESD”). This report covers the fiscal year from April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011. Projects contained in this report are comprised of Proposals for Assistance: Approved, Proposals for Assistance: Evaluated Not Yet Approved and Proposals for Assistance: Evaluated No Further Action Recommended. During this fiscal period, the ESD Directors approved 203 projects totaling \$175,265,016 in funding commitments.

## ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS: APPROPRIATION CATEGORIES

*Projects in the report are funded from the appropriation (and reappropriation) categories listed below.*

- **Downstate Revitalization Fund (“DRF”)** – a one-time appropriation of \$35 million enacted in FY 2008-09 to promote economic development by facilitating the creation and retention of jobs or other economic activity in downstate New York by providing financial assistance via a Request for Proposals process.
- **Downstate Regional Program (“DRP”)** – a \$35 million downstate funding program limited to a number of projects including the SUNY Stony Brook Research Center and the Cold Spring Harbor Laboratory.
- **Entrepreneurial Assistance Program (“EAP”)** – two annual appropriations (total \$1.764 million in FY 2011-12) that establish and maintain Entrepreneurial Assistance Program Centers in local communities to provide instruction, training, technical assistance, and support services to individuals who have recently started their own business or are interested in starting a business.
- **Empire State Economic Development Fund (“EDF”)** – created in 1996 and, until FY 2011-12, an annual appropriation that provides assistance for projects that promote the economic health of New York State by facilitating the creation or retention of jobs or the increase of business activity. There was no appropriation for FY 2011-12; instead, a similar appropriation was made for an Economic Development Purposes Fund which does not yet have activity.
- **Job Development Authority (“JDA”)** – This program provides direct loans for the growth of manufacturing and other eligible businesses within New York State by assisting in financing a portion of the cost of acquiring and renovating existing buildings or constructing new buildings (“Real Estate” projects) or for purchasing machinery and equipment (“M&E” projects). Funds to make loans are derived from the sale of State-guaranteed bonds.
- **JOBS Now Program (“JN”)** – remaining appropriation funds (the last year of new appropriations was FY 2006-07) to promote the state’s economic health and increase economic activity by encouraging the expansion of current businesses and attraction of new businesses, primarily targeting companies that create at least 300 new permanent, full-time private sector jobs, with 25% of funds allowed for the creation of 100-299 jobs.
- **Metropolitan Economic Revitalization Fund (“MERF”)** – a one-time \$25 million fund created in 1996 which seeks to revive economically distressed neighborhoods by offering loans to for-profit and not-for-profit businesses, municipalities, and county governments that retain or create a significant number of private-sector jobs. Loans are made for up to \$5 million or 10 percent of total project costs for capital purposes.
- **Small Business Revolving Loan Fund (“SBRLF”)** – a \$50 million fund designed to create economic activity by providing greater access to capital for small businesses. The program is targeted to small businesses that have had difficulty accessing regular credit markets. The 2010-11 State budget provided \$25 million in state funds and will leverage at least \$25 million in private matching funds.
- **Restore NY Communities Initiative (“Restore NY”)** – a \$300 million appropriation, awarded over three years (FY 2006-07, FY 2007-08, and FY 2008-09), that aids municipalities with real property in need of demolition/deconstruction or rehabilitation or reconstruction for both commercial and residential property.
- **Urban and Community Development Program (“UCDP”)** – an annual appropriation (\$3.404 million in FY 2011-12) that promotes economic development by encouraging economic and employment opportunities in targeted communities and urban areas.
- **Upstate Regional Blueprint Fund (“URB”)** – a one-time appropriation of \$120 million enacted in FY 2008-09 to promote economic development in upstate New York by facilitating the creation and retention of jobs or other economic activity by providing financial assistance via a Request for Proposals process.
