Anita Romero is currently the General Counsel of Global Consumer, directly supporting all consumer businesses in North America and working with the regional consumer general counsels and the general counsel of Citi Holdings. Anita also serves as General Counsel of Citibank, N.A. She most recently held the position of Deputy General Counsel for Citigroup, where, among other corporate legal groups, she oversaw the Anti-Money Laundering, Bank Regulatory, Corporate Governance, Employment Law and Equity Compensation. In previous roles at Citigroup, Anita was Deputy General Counsel, Citigroup International, where she provided legal support for corporate and consumer bank businesses operating in over 80 countries. She has also represented Citigroup and its subsidiaries in a broad variety of public and private transactions including mergers, divestitures, joint ventures, equity investments and internal reorganizations.

Before joining Citigroup in January 1997, Anita spent 12 years with the New York City Economic Development Corporation (EDC), which is the City of New York's primary economic development vehicle. She was First Executive Vice President of EDC from March 1994 through January 1997. Prior to that period, she held a variety of legal positions, the last of which was Senior Vice President Legal Affairs.

Anita is on the Board of Directors of the Moynihan Station Development Corporation dedicated to the redevelopment of the landmark Farley Post Office building in New York City. She was inducted into the YWCA's Academy of Women Leaders in 2009.

Anita received a B.A. in Political Science from SUNY Albany in 1980 and a J.D. from New York Law School in 1983.
