

## LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted General Project Plans (the “Plans”) with respect to the following projects:

Griffiss Institute- Base Retention Capital and Working Capital Project, and

GLDC - Griffiss Institute Expansion – Base Retention Capital Project at the Directors' meeting on January 17, 2013.

Copies of the Plans are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plans in the offices of the City Clerk, City of Rome, City Hall, 198 N. Washington Street, Rome, NY 13440 and the Oneida County Clerk, Oneida County Office Building, 800 Park Avenue, Utica, NY 13501. A copy of the Plans are also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

Griffiss Institute- Base Retention Project includes a technical study, technology development, marketing and base retention activities at 725 Daedalian Drive, Rome by Griffiss Institute. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$485,445. ESD proposes to make a \$298,534 grant to Griffiss Institute to assist in the financing of the Project.

GLDC - Griffiss Institute Expansion – Base Retention Project includes engineering, design, and planning for the expansion of the Griffiss Institute Building located at 725 Daedalian Drive, Rome by Griffiss Local Development Corporation. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$300,000. ESD proposes to make a \$300,000 grant to Griffiss Local Development Corporation to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Common Council Chambers, 198 N. Washington Street, Rome, NY 13440 on Thursday, February 21, 2013 from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. to consider the Plans.
