

## LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Roxbury Volunteer Emergency Services, Inc. - Cascade System Project (the “Project”) at the Directors' meeting on February 21, 2013. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Queens County Clerk at 88-11 Sutphin Boulevard, 1st Floor, Jamaica, NY 11439 and New York City Clerk, Executive Office, 141 Worth Street, New York, NY 10013. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the acquisition of a Cascade System for the filling of Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus at 42 State Road, Breezy Point by Roxbury Volunteer Emergency Services, Inc. This system will allow the RVES fire department to rapidly refill expended SCBA high-pressure vessels (tanks) on scene as needed. New York State firefighting regulations require that fire departments have at least two freshly filled SCBA tanks available for each firefighter on scene. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$61,200. ESD proposes to make a \$61,200 grant to Roxbury Volunteer Emergency Services, Inc. to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the **Queens Library Auditorium, 1637 Central Avenue, Far Rockaway, NY 11691 on Thursday, March 14, 2013 from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.** to consider the Plan.
