

## LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Upstate Empire State Development Corporation, a subsidiary of the New York State Urban Development Corporation doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the GlaxoSmithKline LLC Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on June 27, 2013. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Greene County Clerk at 411 Main Street, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Catskill, NY 12414. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the expansion and upgrade of a warehouse and various smaller buildings, demolition of a waste water treatment facility, construction of a new 10,650 SF treatment plant, upgrades to storm water and treatment systems, new machinery and equipment and general site improvements at 3169 NYS Route 145, Oak Hill by GlaxoSmithKline LLC. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$56,700,000. ESD proposes to make a \$900,000 grant to GlaxoSmithKline LLC to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project is expected to retain 190 jobs through January 1, 2016 after disbursement of the ESD funds.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Durham Town Hall at 7309 State Route 81, East Durham, NY 12423 on July 16, 2013 at 10:30 a.m., to consider the Plan.
