

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”) has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Hamilton County Broadband Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on March 20, 2013. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Hamilton County Clerk at 102 County View Drive, Lake Pleasant, NY 12108. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the installation of broadband infrastructure and network connections throughout Hamilton County and parts of Fulton County at these locations: Lake Pleasant, Wells, Indian Lake, North Creek, Lake Luzerne, Raquette Lake, Blue Mountain Lake, Eagle Bay, Long Lake, Gloversville, Northville, Mayfield, Broadalbin, and Johnstown by Hamilton County. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$524,444; ESD proposes to make a \$472,000 grant to Hamilton County to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project supports existing business entities and creates new opportunities for Hamilton County to cultivate economic development and create new employment. The project supports the North Country Regional Economic Development Council’s vision to attract entrepreneurs and to form innovative clusters in rural communities.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Hamilton County Court House, 102 County View Drive, Lake Pleasant, NY, on April 8, 2013, at 11:00 a.m., to consider the Plan.
