

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Brooklyn Navy Yard/Macro Sea New Lab Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on August 22, 2013. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Kings County Clerk, Supreme Court Building, 360 Adams Street, Room 189, Brooklyn, NY 11201 and the New York City Clerk of the Council, Executive Office, 141 Worth Street, New York, NY 10013. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the design, renovation, and fit out of 84,000 square feet of space into a high-tech design and prototyping center at 63 Flushing Avenue, Building 128, Brooklyn by Brooklyn Navy Yard Development Corporation. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$19.8 million. ESD proposes to make a \$3,250,000 grant to the Brooklyn Navy Yard Development Corporation to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project is expected to retain 5 jobs and create 8 jobs within 3 years after disbursement of the ESD funds.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at Brooklyn Borough Hall, Borough President’s Conference Room, First Floor, 209 Joralemon Street, Brooklyn, NY 11201 on Tuesday, September 10, 2013 from 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM , to consider the Plan.
