

## LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Utica Memorial Auditorium Facility Improvement Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on August 22, 2013. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Oneida County Clerk, Oneida County Clerk Building, 800 Park Avenue, Utica, NY 13501 and the Utica City Clerk, One Kennedy Plaza, Utica, NY 13502. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the renovation of facilities at 400 Oriskany Street West, Utica by Upper Mohawk Valley Memorial Auditorium Authority. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$2,000,000. ESD proposes to make a \$2,000,000 grant to Upper Mohawk Valley Memorial Auditorium Authority to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Utica City Hall, Common Council Chambers, First floor, One Kennedy Plaza, Utica, NY 13502 on Tuesday, September 10, 2013 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM , to consider the Plan.
