

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the American Institute of Chemical Engineers Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on September 19, 2013. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the New York County Clerk, Executive Office, 141 Worth Street, New York, NY 10013, City Clerk, Borough of Manhattan, 60 Centre Street, Room 161, New York, NY 10007 and the Manhattan Borough President, 1 Centre Street – 19th Floor, New York, NY 10007. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the purchase of furniture fixtures & equipment associated with the relocation to a leased facility at 120 Wall Street, New York by American Institute of Chemical Engineers. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$817,000. ESD proposes to make a \$100,000 grant to American Institute of Chemical Engineers to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project is expected to retain 59 jobs and create 13 jobs within 5 years after disbursement of the ESD funds.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at Community Board 1, 49-51 Chambers Street - Room 715, New York, NY 10007, Conference Room 705 on Thursday, October 10, 2013 from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. to consider the Plan.
