

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Fort Schuyler Management Corporation - Quad C Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on November 18, 2013. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Oneida County Clerk at the Oneida County Office Building, 800 Park Avenue, Utica, NY 13501 and the Marcy Town Clerk at the Marcy Town Building, 8801 Paul Becker Road, Marcy, NY 13403. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the construction of the first phase of the Quad C, a 253-000-square-foot facility containing flex space that will include clean rooms, laboratories, offices, lecture center and related utilities adjacent to the State University of New York Institute of Technology (“SUNYIT”) campus in Marcy, Oneida County. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$50,970,551. ESD proposes to make a \$15,000,000 grant to Fort Schuyler Management Corporation to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project is expected to create 300 jobs by January 1, 2018.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the SUNYIT, Kunsela Hall, Gannett Art Gallery, 5701 Horatio Street, Utica, NY 13502 on Wednesday, December 11, 2013 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM, to consider the Plan.
