

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Kings County Surveillance Cameras Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on November 18, 2013. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Kings County Clerk, Supreme Court Building, 360 Adams Street Rm 198, Brooklyn, NY 11201 and the New York City Clerk of the Council, Executive Office, 141 Worth Street, New York, NY 10013. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the acquisition of eight ARGUS surveillance cameras throughout the 61st, 62nd, 63rd, and 68th police precincts in Kings County within the 22nd New York State Senate District. The neighborhoods will include Bay Ridge, Dyker Heights, Bensonhurst, Marine Park, Gerritsen Beach, Gravesend and parts of Sheepshead Bay, Borough Park and Midwood. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$300,000 ESD proposes to make a \$300,000 grant to New York City Police Department to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at Brooklyn Borough Hall, Borough President’s Conference Room, First Floor, 209 Joralemon Street, Brooklyn, NY 11201 on Monday, December 9, 2013 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM, to consider the Plan.
