

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Oneida County - Hurricane Irene - Tropical Storm Lee Flood Mitigation Capital Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on November 18, 2013. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Oneida County Clerk at Oneida County Office Building, 800 Park Avenue, Utica, NY 13501; the Utica City Clerk at One Kennedy Plaza, Utica, NY 13502; the Whitestown Town Clerk at 8539 Clark Mills Road, Whitesboro, NY 13492; the New Hartford Town Clerk at Butler Hall- 48 Genesee Street, New Hartford, NY 13413 and the Kirkland Town Clerk at 3699 State Route 12B- PO Box 235, Clinton, NY 13323. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project will entail flood mitigation activities to reduce future flooding at the Project Locations at City of Utica, Towns of Whitestown, New Hartford, Kirkland in Oneida County by Oneida County. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$1,109,194 and ESD proposes to make a \$408,211 grant to Oneida County to assist in the financing of the Project. The Project is expected to reduce future flooding at the Project Locations.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at Utica City Hall, Common Council Chambers, First Floor, One Kennedy Plaza, Utica, NY 13502 on Monday, December 9, 2013 from 9:30 AM to 10:30 AM, to consider the Plan.
