

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT TO
ATLANTIC YARDS CONSTRUCTION UPDATE
Weeks of May 10, 2010 and May 17, 2010

This is a Supplemental Report to the previously issued two week look – ahead regarding upcoming construction activities at Atlantic Yards covering the period of May 10, 2010 through May 23, 2010

The following section has been modified to include new information:

Demolition

- Filings for demolition permits for 467 Dean Street, 475 Dean Street and 648 Pacific in are in process.
- Demolition of 467 Dean Street and 648 Pacific Street is expected to begin within the two week period. Interior demolition of 475 Dean Street is expected to begin within the two week period.
- Site control has been secured for 481 Dean, 483-485 Dean and 38 6th Avenue. Demolition bids either have been secured or are in the process of being secured. Filings for abatement will be commencing.
- New Information: Demolition is expected to be done by mechanical means. This approach requires that the construction fence be erected at the curb of the sidewalk to achieve a setback from the site for safety purposes. On or about May 17th, the northern sidewalk of Dean Street between Flatbush and 6th Avenues will be temporarily closed to the public and the fence will start to be erected. The permit for the sidewalk closure is for 90 days and public notice with an alternate pedestrian path is attached.
- New Information: Each building will be demolished pursuant to its own abatement and demolition permits.

COMMUNITY NOTICE

Temporary Closure of Sidewalk on Dean Street

Beginning on May 15, 2010

Beginning on Saturday, May 15, 2010, the north sidewalk of Dean Street (between Flatbush and Sixth Avenues) will be temporarily closed to accommodate the Atlantic Yards project construction. On-street parking will be unaffected.

The temporary closure is anticipated to be in place for a period of approximately 90 days. Pedestrians can continue to use the south sidewalk on Dean Street. Pedestrian detour signs will be posted during the work.
